NDIS Training and Skills Support Strategy (NTSSS) is an industry-led, multifaceted approach to developing a quality workforce capable of delivering services reflective of the needs of NDIS participants across Queensland. The projected need for disability workforce growth and the resulting demand for skills and training present a number of complex challenges

PURPOSE

NTSSS is an industry-led initiative with the ultimate goal of ensuring that there are enough workers with the skills, knowledge and attributes to meet NDIS workforce demand where and when it emerges.

GOVERNANCE

WorkAbility Queensland is led by a consortium of industry bodies in collaboration with key government agencies. The consortium includes National Disability Services (NDS), Community Services Industry Alliance (CSIA), and Queensland Council of Social Service (QCOSS).

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The NTSSS will focus on upskilling the workforce to meet the requirements of the new NDIS framework through training and professional development activities. With recruitment based on the values and attributes of the individual, and reflective of the diversity of NDIS participants the NTSSS will grow the NDIS workforce. A further focus area will be on improving VET quality with consideration of workplace learning, skills requirements, and NDIS core principles.

The program will seek to understand training and skills development needs to improve training and skills interventions by collaborating with employers to understand industry needs; taking a flexible approach to respond to diversity of workforce development needs and utilising evidence-based solutions. This will lead to an increased supply of new skills workers in the NDIS workforce; increased retention of upskilled workers in the existing NDIS workforce and will lead to sustainable improvement in the VET system.
