Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Existing Workforce Development

For this project, the **Institute for Urban Indigenous Health (IUIH)** aims to **equip and grow a direct care workforce** to meet the needs of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples that can be **deployed across disability and home care support services**.

An Innovative Care Model

The **IUIH System of Care** is a **regionally integrated model** of expanded community, aged and primary health care services for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people across SEQ. It addresses **social determinants of health** and provides a **comprehensive workforce development strategy** comprising training and employment for its workforce.

Project Aim

This project expands the IUIH System of Care to **increase Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples' access to sustainable and viable employment** through meaningful & culturally appropriate training, and to ensure **culturally safe care and ways of working** with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.
