Project Profile:

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Community Controlled Organisation Management Capability

For this project, the **Institute for Urban Indigenous Health (IUIH)** will **integrate NDIS access, coordination, and service provision with its primary health care model** by building on trusted and established culturally safe ACCHS relationships to ensure seamless navigation through the health, aged and disability care systems.

Project Aim

This project helps to overcome **system navigation challenges** and workforce requirements of the NDIS which are new to IUIH. Three initiatives will **support and upskill the leadership development** of staff working in key integration roles that support and meet the needs of NDIS participants within IUIH's System of Care:

1. Six-month **emerging-leaders program**
2. Twelve-week **Care Coordination/ Case Management Program**
3. Upskilling workers in Cert IV Training and Assessing Skill Set to help train and equip others.
