Project Profile:

Developing a Placement Agency

For this project, **Community Resource Unit (CRU)** will trial the development of a **Placement Agency** with up to **12 people with lived experience of disability** to support **10 students on vocational placements** for the Certificate III in Individual Support.

The Placement Agency will:

- engage people with lived experience to **lead the delivery of the vocational placement as workplace supervisors and/or trainers and assessors**
- be a central hub that connects RTOs and students with their workplace supervisors
- support students to **complete placement hours in the homes of people with disability**
- provide **ongoing support** during placement

Innovation in Vocational Placements

The Placement Agency brings to life phase one of this project, where CRU **co-designed practice frameworks with people with disability** and their family members who self-manage supports, to explore **innovative new models** that support students who are undertaking their accredited training.
